A hub for agriculture

The Gippsland Agricultural Group (GAgG) has received funding to build the Gippsland Agricultural Centre.

Located at the Gippsland Research Farm near Bairnsdale at the entry point to the East Gippsland Field Days site, this centre will be the hub of a thriving agricultural precinct.

This project has been three years in the making, and received \$984,000 from the Black Summer Bushfire Recovery Program.

GAgG applied for a grant in late 2021 and were successful in 2022.

Unfortunately, they were caught with the increase in price of steel thanks to COVID (inflation on costs were 30-35 per cent), hence the delay in building.

The grant funds were no longer enough to

cover the cost of the initial plans so they had to go back to the drawing board and make adjustments.

There has been an immense amount of community and volunteer effort that has gone into this building, without that support GAgG would not have been able to accomplish as much as they have.

Volunteer hours include:

- The executive team volunteering all project management hours
- Painting
- Landscaping
- Plumbing fit off

It's hoped this building will be a valuable asset to the community for many years to come.

Isuzu's focus on evolution

Over the years the typical one-tonne ute has evolved from a simple two door cab chassis to a versatile utility for all occasions—with space for the family in air-conditioned comfort, cargo out back in the tray and 3.5-tonne towing capacity for the trailer in tow.

After introducing the most significant update since launching in late-2020, the 2023 (23MY) D-MAX range refined with new features, new variants, and a refreshed exterior design and colour palette has grown in popularity to chart as Australia's third best-selling vehicle in 2023.

Favoured for the hardy, wipe-clean surfaces, and tradesman focus, the SX grade added three new variants to the range, all powered by Isuzu's frugal RZ4E-TC 1.9-litre turbo-diesel engine, paired with a six-speed automatic transmission.

After a successful Australian debut powering the 2022 D-MAX SX Single Cab Chassis 4x2, the RZ4E-TC quickly earned its stripes with motorists as a fuel efficient and versatile powerplant, one that arrived at the right time as fuel prices at the bowser soared to record heights.

With the cost of living at an all-time high and many relying on their ute as a tool of trade or the family hauler, getting the most out of their four-wheel investment remains of paramount importance for many motorists.

After crunching the numbers to simulate real-world costs to own and operate each ute over three-years, both the 1.9-litre and 3.0-litre turbo-diesel powered variants of the popular D-MAX SX Crew Cab 4x4 Ute were declared the two best-value 4x4 utes in Australia for the Wheels' inaugural Best Value 4x4 Ute awards.

Since the launch of the current generation D-MAX in 2020, Isuzu has introduced refinements to its active safety suite to improve the



functionality and user experience.

And, with close to half of all D-MAX owners choosing the Isuzu for its towing prowess, Isuzu engineers have simplified the towing setup process by automatically disabling Blind Spot Monitoring and Rear Cross Traffic Alert when a trailer is hitched and detected via the genuine trailer wiring harness.

This refinement comes just a year after Isuzu introduced the Lane Support System Switch that allows the Driver to toggle lane keeping functions on or off, at the simple push of a button.

Australians have long adored the D-MAX as one of the top-choices in the ute segment, praising it for its practicality, versatility, and

reputation for durability. Favoured by families as the default choice for any assignment, it can often be seen doubling duties as a workhorse during the week, and a vehicle of escape and adventure during the weekend.

Lucas Mill 30th anniversary

Lucas Mill reached a major milestone in March 2024, when the Australian family-owned company celebrated its 30th anniversary.

Lucas Mill had its debut in March 1994 and has been an amazing success story since that time.

Lucas Mill had a business plan to sell 50 Lucas Mills in its first 12 months and was blown away by its instant success, when they received orders for 50 Lucas mills in the first six weeks.

Thirty years, on Lucas Mill continues to enjoy success both in Australian and international markets, with more than 23,000 mills sold into over 100 countries.

They have huge diversity of markets from the Jungles of Papua New Guinea to Lakes District in England.

Their product range has expanded over time to include five Circular Blade Mill (with Electric option for Model 8 and 10), three dedicated Slabber Mills (including the Super Slabber which can slab up to 2.8m) and a large range of Optional Extras Complete Planer Kits to weatherboard attachments.

They have international distributors in all major countries, who have been with all with the company almost since its inception.

Dairy automation your way

If it's time to upgrade your dairy, you're in luck. Installing an automated milking system is now cost comparable to installing a traditional system, and the team at Lely Center Gippsland have the experience to design a system that works with your infrastructure - from robot retrofits to incorporating feed pads and keeping cows moving on a voluntary, pasture-based system.

"Every farm set-up is different and you can get into automation without breaking the bank", says Center Manager Dale Serong.

"Last week, we started up four robots that we installed into a disused herringbone shed. On another farm, the yard of the rotary dairy had a roof put over it and then six robots were bolted in.

"We've worked with enough setups now, optimising them over time with the clients to get the results they're after, we know what

works and what doesn't.

"We have a large and highly experienced team based on the ground in Gippsland, from robot installers and technicians to robot software and farm management experts. Not to mention dozens of Lely robot farmers in Gippsland now that share knowledge between farms. It's a real support network."

Lely Center Gippsland installed 35 Lely Astronaut milking robots on Gippsland farms in 2023, and now support more than 80 milking robots across the region.

They also specialise in automatic calf feeders and automatic feed pushers, which are becoming more common locally as farmers incorporate feed pads into their robotic systems.

Dale explains that designing Lely Astronaut setups is easy because of the walk-through robot box design they call "i-flow".

Cows walk straight into the stall and the robot arm uses

a 3D camera and laser system to meet the cow where she is and put cups on, saving time by remembering the last 10 mappings of that cow.

This means the Astronaut suits all sizes of cows and provides freedom of movement inside the box, with studies showing four per cent improved cow flow compared to no i-flow.

"Lely designs their robots around the cow's needs and natural behaviour, so they're motivated to continue visiting the machines", Dale said.

"This is sixth generation technology, so the current A5 model is the result of refining that technology. Its water and electricity efficiency are also excellent. These are the advantages that come with decades of research and development."

Lely Center Gippsland will be at site R25 at the East Gippsland Field Days, Bairnsdale Aerodrome, from April 5 and 6.

Improving heart health in Gippsland

Taking proactive steps to improve heart health outcomes in Gippsland, Latrobe Health Services will be offering free 15-minute heart health checks at the East Gippsland Field Days in Bairnsdale from Friday, April 5, to Saturday, April 6.

Gippsland's heart health statistics paint a concerning picture, with the region experiencing some of the worst health outcomes in Australia.

To combat this issue, Latrobe Health Services is urging individuals aged between 18 and 50 years to participate in the health screenings.

Ian Whitehead, chief executive officer of Latrobe Health Services, said the heart health checks were an effective way to help both members and the broader community assess their risk factors.

"We've been providing free heart health checks since 2022," Mr Whitehead said.

"Over time, this commitment has evolved into an ongoing community outreach program. Through partnerships, such as the one with the Shane Warne Legacy, Latrobe Health has been able to extend its reach and impact, testing over 30,000 participants."

The heart health checks provided by the Healthy Hearts team at the East Gippsland Field Days are free of charge and require no prior booking.

Located in the General Interest Arena, these screenings offer attendees the opportunity to assess key indicators of heart health.

These include blood pressure, heart rate, body composition, diabetes risk, and non-fasting cholesterol levels.

"Results are provided immediately following the test, with the health professional

providing key insights on the results, advice on how to keep your heart healthy, and informing participants on how to follow up with your GP if further action is required," Mr Whitehead said.





The first four things we can focus on to help strengthen our relationship with our dogs are:

CALM - Our dogs can pick up on the physical changes in our body, before we even know how we are feeling.

So when you come home grumpy from work, your dog can mirror this and be more 'cheeky'.

Take a deep breath and leave your day at the door.

Or if you want to interact with your dog, go and do something stress free and fun - like run through some tricks, go on a sniffari or have an exploration in the yard.

CLEAR - Setting up clear expectations and boundaries is a must.

It's so easy (particularly in multiple people households) to send mixed messages to your dog. For example being allowed to jump up to say hello on one person, but not another.

For example if you are worried about

walking past another dog, our inclination is to hold our breath, tense up and pull on the lead - your dog can then be worried about the situation (because you are) before they have even seen a dog.

So before you work with your dog (in any capacity) take a deep breath, shake off your daily stress, set a clear goal and most importantly have fun.


